Organizers

The program is jointly organized by the School of Professional and Continuing Education, the University of Hong Kong (HKU SPACE) and the International Council on Archives - East Asian Regional Branch (EASTICA).

The Program

This is a 3-week full-time intensive course designed for archivists or those engaging in records management related functions who wish to update their professional knowledge and skills, widen their international exposure and obtain an academic qualification for the profession. The programme aims to guide students to plan, establish and manage archives in their organization to meet business, legal, fiscal, public relations and cultural needs.

The programme introduces:

- i) the most updated theories and practices in archival administration;
- ii) theories and practices in records appraisal, arrangement, description and conservation;
- iii) the use of archives and its social and cultural significance
- iv) the management of paper and electronic record throughout their life-cycle.

Programme Structure

Lecturers

All lectures and seminars are conducted by academics, archives specialists and leading experts from Europe, North America, Australia and Asia.

Chief Lecturer

The Chief Lecturer of this course is Simon F.K CHU, Adjunct Associate Professor of both the Chinese University of Hong Kong and Hong Kong University School of Professional and Continuing Education. Professor CHU was educated in Hong Kong, Canada and UK where he obtained his degrees in History, Information Science and Law. Professor CHU is former Director of the Hong Kong Government Records Services where he had helped building the infrastructure for a service-wide records and archives management system. Professor CHU has also held executive and advisory positions in a number of local, national and international organizations and committees responsible for archival and heritage programs.

Admission

Applicants shall hold a bachelor's degree awarded by a recognized university; preferably with 2 years records, archives or relevant work experience and possess English proficiency at a score of 550 in the paper-based TOEFL.

Applicants with other qualifications and relevant work experience will be considered on individual merits.

Assessment

The Postgraduate Certificate in Archival Studies is jointly issued by EASTICA and HKU SPACE, and awarded to students who have achieved a pass in assignment and the written report; and have 80% of attendance.
